Applications are invited for filling in the position of 20 Fellows under the **Goa Chief Minister's Fellowship Programme for the year 2026-27** from the eligible candidates by the Director, Directorate of Planning, Statistics & Evaluation, Government of Goa, Porvorim, Bardez, Goa.

DETAILS ABOUT GOA CHIEF MINISTER'S FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME

Total Fellows to be selected:	20 Nos. across the disciplines
Essential Qualification:	i. Graduate/ Post Graduate degree in any discipline from a recognized University/ Institution.
	Candidate must have secured First Class in Graduation/ Post Graduation.
	ii. Experience in the relevant fields.
	iii. 15 years Resident Certificate
	iv. Must have passed Std. X and XII public examinations from the State of Goa.
	v. Knowledge of Konkani language.
	vi. The candidate should be fluent in all forms of communication in English language.
Desirable:	Knowledge of Marathi
Age limit:	Must be below 45 years

1. Government reserves the right to shortlist candidates based on qualifications and experience. Only shortlisted candidates will be called for an interview.
2. All the certificates shall be verified at the time of interview. The candidature is liable for disqualification, if any of the documents/certificate(s) are not found valid or as per eligibility criteria at the time of verification.
3. The shortlisted applicants shall be called for the oral interview. The date of oral interview will be communicated through e-mail to the respective applicants.
4. List of shortlisted candidates will be displayed on the official website of this Directorate on www.goadpse.gov.in. For any further assistance/queries e-mail may be forwarded on 'dir-dpse.goa@gov.in'.
5. **Thematic Areas:** The selected Fellows will be required to work upon at least one of the thematic areas of agriculture & allied activities, industries, renewable energy, education, health, Ayurveda, Pharmacy, skill development, women empowerment, finance, welfare, planning, revenue, Artificial Intelligence (AI), Robotics, Computer, new innovative technology and urban reforms. The subjects of the thematic areas will be distributed in accordance to the selected candidates selected by the Directorate of Planning, Statistics & Evaluation from time to time.
6. **Duration/Period of Fellowship:** 12 months (Including one month of training).
7. **Amount of Fellowship:** There will be a training programme for the first month and a stipend of ₹ 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) will be given during the training period. Thereafter, for the remaining 11 months Fellowship of ₹ 40,000/- per month (Rupees Forty Thousand only) will be provided.
